Registration is to be paid prior to commencement of the course, and is non-refundable. Once you have registered, you will receive the course notes, Tui Na jacket, Tui Na blanket, anmo rou massage cream and the DVD *Tui Na -Student to Master*.

Tuina certificate course

Covers the diagnostic principles, hand techniques, routines and Qi aspects of Tui Na. Hands-on lessons where you will be working in pairs throughout the day. Taught once a month, usually a Sunday, in a classroom environment. 80 hours minimum (approx 10 monthly sessions).

The Clinical Element

Practice the routines and hand techniques studied in the first set of classes. 120 hours are required to complete this module. Places must be reserved in advance on a weekly basis and space is limited to 4 students per clinic to maintain maximum student to teacher ratio. Unless you are a trained Tui Na practitioner you must have completed the Theory and Practice of the hand techniques course before this one.

Tuina and Traditional Chinese Medicine diploma course

This module has been designed for the non- TCM practitioner. You will be taught the concept of Qi, yin/yang and zang/fu theory, an introduction to the 5 elements and 8 principles, the locations and uses of the 12 meridians and commonly used acu/Tui Na points. You will also be taught the 10 questions to enable you to take a thorough case history. The TCM course consists of 60 hours classroom time with 80 hours clinical study and 40 hours case histories. The Case Histories consist of 10 cases to be taken with a minimum of 4 treatments per case history.

Anatomy and Physiology EXTRA MODULE

Anatomy and Physiology is a distance learning course run by Essentials for Health. You will receive a DVD featuring over 20 hours of teaching, a comprehensive manual, pre-prepared sheets, revision notes and self assessment questions. One evening a week for 12 weeks, a telephone conference call of about an hour is offered with an Essentials for Health tutor to have any questions answered.
